

Due to the scheduled airport closure on specific dates during the year, our logistical operations to Napo Wildlife Center will require some adjustments to flight schedules and transportation coordination.

In order to maintain an efficient operation and avoid additional river transportation costs, operations will be conducted using Aeroregional flights on the Quito – Coca – Quito route.

Below you will find the operational logistics for passenger arrivals and departures, along with important information to consider when planning the trip.

Arrival Operation

- ✂ Passengers must arrive at the airport one hour and a half before departure.
- ✂ Liability waivers will be signed at Quito Airport.
- ✂ A box lunch will be provided at Quito Airport.

Estimated Arrival

- ✂ Napo Wildlife Center: approx. 18h30

For passengers staying at Napo Wildlife Center, an optional night walk may be offered on the first day, allowing guests to enjoy an additional activity during their first evening at the lodge.

Departure Operation – Napo Wildlife Center Passengers

- ✂ Breakfast at the lodge.
- ✂ A canoe exploration of the creek may be offered before departure.
- ✂ Departure from the lodge approximately between 08h30 and 09h00 am.
- ✂ A box lunch will be provided to be delivered either on the canoe or in El Coca.

We recommend that passengers carry in their personal backpack or hand luggage the necessary items for their lodge arrival. This will help reduce waiting times in El Coca, while the main luggage will be transported directly by our staff to the cabins.
